



SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES AND APPLICATION

The National Association of State Judicial Educators (NASJE) piloted this program last year (2008) to seek out members who may need assistance to attend the NASJE Annual Conference. NASJE recognizes the financial hardships that many states are currently having and we know that this venue is the only one of its kind for Judicial Educators nationwide. The networking opportunity and the sharing of resources at this event is what makes it unique and we want to encourage membership attendance at this event. The three main factors the NASJE Board Scholarship Subcommittee will use to determine to whom to grant the scholarships will be: **stewardship to NASJE, financial hardship and geographic diversity.**

Funds are available to judicial branch educators, who are **current members** of NASJE.

Applications are due by **June 1, 2009**. The applications will be reviewed by the NASJE Board Scholarship Subcommittee and applicants will receive notice of approval or denial by **June 15, 2009**. **Applications that are not received by June 1, 2009 will not be accepted.**

Judicial Branch Educators must have pursued other resources and determined that they will be able to attend the conference only with the assistance of a scholarship. Please note that the scholarship will cover the conference registration only. Scholarship recipients will need to cover their own travel and per diem expenses.

1. Print or type all information requested on the application form.
2. All scholarship decisions, upon request of the applicant, can be reconsidered by the NASJE president, president-elect, and past president.
3. Priority for funding will be given to applicants who are not prior scholarship recipients.
4. Conditions for receipt of the scholarship are stipulated in the letter of approval. Attendance at the program indicates acceptance of conditions outlined in the letter of approval.
