2022 NASJE CONFERENCE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

The National Association of State Judicial Educators (NASJE) developed this scholarship program to seek out members who may need assistance to attend the NASJE Annual Conference. NASJE recognizes the financial hardships that many states and organizations are currently experiencing, and we know that this venue is the only one of its kind for Judicial Branch Educators nationwide. The networking opportunities and the sharing of resources at this event are what make it unique, and we want to encourage membership attendance at this event.

This year the NASJE Board has decided to offer five scholarships consisting of a waiver of the \$600 Annual Conference registration fee.

Applicants must be **current members** of NASJE. Preference will be given to members who have not received a scholarship within the last two years.

The two primary factors the NASJE Board Scholarship Subcommittee will use to determine who to recommend as scholarship recipients are:

Stewardship to NASJE (active involvement in and contributions to the organization)

Financial need

An additional criterion that will be used if necessary is geographic diversity.

Applications are due by Friday, August 5, 2022. The applications will be reviewed by the NASJE Board Scholarship Subcommittee with final approval by the Board. Applicants will receive notice of whether they will receive a scholarship by September 9, 2022.

Applicants must have pursued other resources and determined that the assistance of a scholarship is critical to their attendance at the conference. (Please note that the scholarships consist of a waiver of the \$600 conference registration fee only.)

1. Print or type all information requested on the application form. Send it as an attachment (either the fillable PDF or a scanned copy) and email it to NASJE President Todd Brower at brower@law.ucla.edu by Friday, August 5, 2022.
2. Scholarship recipients must attend the entire conference. Any scholarship recipient who is unable to attend the conference must commit to informing NASJE President Todd Brower by email immediately. By applying for a scholarship, applicants are indicating acceptance of these conditions.
